PERMISSION TO LEAVE CAMPUS FORM
12th Grade Students

The Cambridge School of Dallas has a policy permitting seniors, with the permission of their parents/guardians, to utilize Open Campus. Open Campus is a privilege aimed at increasing student achievement while offering a learning environment that provides our students freedom with respect and responsibility.

Students must exit and reenter the building through the main entrance, and they must also sign-out and sign-in following standard Cambridge procedures. A student may be denied access to the Open Campus privilege at any time for not meeting the academic, attendance or behavioral standards set forth by The Cambridge School of Dallas.

Parents: Assume the responsibility of their child during his/her time off campus. Students are expected to be present and on time for class, chapel and assemblies. They are also expected to conduct themselves as good citizens when off campus. All student code of conduct rules apply to students when they are off campus.

Seniors: The Open Campus privileges apply, with parental permission, during study hall and lunch periods and is not allowed during academic class periods or flex period, including clubs, school assemblies, house meetings, and chapels. Permission is contingent upon acting responsibly while in school and maintaining satisfactory academic work. This privilege may be revoked for any student who forfeits his/her good standing*. If you need to miss class for any reason, your parent or guardian must contact the school to release you for those periods or you will need to provide appropriate documentation upon your return (doctor's note, etc).

*Open campus privileges are conditional and may be revoked for any behavioral, academic, or attendance violations. Revocation of open campus is left to the discretion of the school administration. Abuse of Open Campus privileges, including skipping class or mandatory events, will result in suspension of privileges, including extra-curricular activities.

Having read the preceding guidelines, I give permission for my child to leave The Cambridge School of Dallas' campus during study hall and lunch periods. I accept responsibility for him/her during the time he/she is not in school.

Open Campus Incentive Guidelines: The guidelines below will be used in determining eligibility for Open Campus.

Academic: Students must be in good academic standing in all classes. This means that students may lose their Open Campus privilege if they fail a class or are in danger of failing a class.

Attendance: Students may lose their Open Campus privileges for excessive absences or tardies.

Behavior: Students will lose their Open Campus privileges for behavioral infractions as determined by the Cambridge administration.
